

	The actions of the ECB and other central banks - in particular, negative interest rates, QE and (specifically) the third covered bond purchase programme - are changing the covered bond market in a profound but difficult to predict way. What are the implications including on the structure of the investor base, liquidity and the long term future of the asset class?	This panel will look at HAA, what happened, what are the implications for the covered bond market and what lessons can be learned (accepting that this may still be a fluid situation at the date of the conference). In addition it will discuss the new resolution rules, their interaction with state aid rules (and therefore the probability of state support for failing banks in future) and whether the EBA best practices really ensure that a covered bond will survive the new forms of bank failure.	For covered bond investors wanting to diversify from European risk, Australia and Canada have been the main opportunities so far. But with Singapore, South Korea and potentially other markets opening up, what are the opportunities and risks in the Asian jurisdictions? What lessons can the new Asian issuers draw from the Australian example? This roundtable will assess the latest transactions, investor appetite and the outlook for market growth in the next 12 months.
